be *home* while their brother or sister is *at camp*.
- Schedule a *Sibling Weekend* during winter break.
- Honor siblings in one of your Camp Newsletters during the year.
- Host a *Sibling Sunday Fun-day* near April 10th to honor National Sibling Day.
- Remind your campers to **WRITE LETTERS HOME** to their brothers and sisters telling
them how special they are!
- School Vacation – Sibling *Day Camp* (outings, field trips, etc..)
- Encourage campers to *think about* and *talk about* how their siblings have been a part of (or
not a part of) their cancer journey.
